

ORDINANCE NO. 05-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AMENDING ORDINANCE 84-13 RELATING TO THE RICHMOND HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond passed Ordinance 84-13 on June 19, 1984 creating a Richmond Human Rights Commission, and

WHEREAS, after a review of the Ordinance an Amendment is necessary in order to be an all inclusive ordinance,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richmond Board of Commissioners:

Section I

Ordinance 84-13 of the City of Richmond is hereby amended as follows:

Amending
Section II – Policy

It is the public policy of the City of Richmond to promote fair treatment and equal opportunity for all people [~~persons~~] regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex [~~er~~], age [~~between 40 and 70~~] or physical disability of any type:

Amending
Section III – Definitions

- a. “Discrimination” means any direct or indirect act or practice of exclusion, distinction, restriction, segregation, limitation, refusal, denial or any other act or practice or differentiation or preference in the treatment of a person because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex [~~er~~], age [~~between 40 and 70~~], or physical disability of any type

Amending
Section V Functions

- A. The Commission shall encourage fair treatment and equal opportunity for all people [~~persons~~] regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, [~~er~~] age [~~between 40 and 70~~], or physical disability of any type and shall promote mutual understanding and respect among all economic, social, racial, religious, sex, age, and ethnic groups; and shall endeavor to eliminate discrimination against, and antagonism between, religious, racial, sex, age, physical disability of any type, and ethnic groups and their members.

Section II

All other parts of Ordinance 84-13 are in full force and effect as if set out in full herewith.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon second reading and adoption by the City of Richmond Board of Commissioners.




