

ORDINANCE NO. 19-13

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 13-20 PERTAINING TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE
CITY'S SAFETY OFFICER**

WHEREAS, the City, by Ordinance No. 13-20, did create the position of city safety officer and set forth the powers and duties of that position; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the public interest to amend that ordinance in the particulars hereinafter set forth so as to permit the safety officer to perform a duty not authorized by the provisions of Ordinance No. 13-20;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that:

Section II, subpart (H) of Ordinance No. 13-20 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(H) Investigate and report minor, non-injury traffic accidents, as well as any other traffic accidents, including those with resultant personal injury if, but only if, the safety officer has completed not less than 240 hours of training in accident reconstruction and has been so authorized by the Chief of Police.

Except as amended as above set forth, Ordinance No. 13-20 shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its present tenor.

This Ordinance shall become effectively immediately upon its enactment by the Board of Commissioners following second reading, and publication in accordance with the requirements of applicable Kentucky law.
