

ORDINANCE NO. 21-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY AS PUBLIC WAYS AND CITY STREETS FOR ALL PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the developer of the Sycamore Park Subdivision, (the “Subdivision”) has completed the construction of the streets, curbs, and gutters within the Subdivision and has called for the inspection by the City of that infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Department of Public Works has inspected the infrastructure and found it to be in compliance with the requirements of applicable City ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners accordingly finds it to be in the public interest that that infrastructure be approved for the City’s acceptance of the dedication of the infrastructure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that:

SECTION I

The City does hereby accept the dedication of the following streets, including curbs, gutters, and sidewalks, within the Subdivision, depicted on the final plat of the Subdivision approved by the Richmond Planning and Zoning Commission and of record in the office of the Madison County Court Clerk, as public ways for all purposes, to wit:

- Loblolly Lane
- Oleander Way
- Mimosa Drive


SECTION II
